



2011 2nd Annual Honor Show Chow Jackpot

Sunday, June 12, 2011 – Showmanship will begin at 9:00 AM followed by Steer Show then the Heifer Show (British, Continental, and Commercial Divisions)

Rules and Regulations:

1. All exhibitors must be between the ages of 9 and 18 years on August 27.
2. Open to Steers born on or after August 1, 2010 & Heifers born on or after September 1, 2010.
3. All Steers and Heifers will be shown by weight.
4. Heifer Show (British, Continental, Commercial Divisions)
5. Each exhibitor/owner must assume all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and any injury or death incurred by his/her animal.

Judge:

1. Our Judge is Bob May from Mineral Point, WI
2. Bob is a Honor Show Chow Ambassador
3. May Cattle Company specialization is grooming, judging, showing & breeding.
4. Bob has 36 years of experience in the field

Entries:

1. There will be no maximum number of entries per exhibitor.
2. There is a \$25 entry fee per head, \$10 entry for showmanship. Checks payable to: Land O' Lakes Purina Feed. Entry Deadline: Postmarked by June 1, 2011.
3. No refunds on pre-registrations. You can substitute a different animal or exhibitor.
4. Late Entries will be accepted up to check-in on June 11. A \$10 late fee will be applied to each entry.
5. ALL INFORMATION AND SIGNATURES MUST BE COMPLETED. Use separate entry blanks for each exhibitor.

Health Regulations:

1. Each calf must be accompanied by a valid set of Health Papers and presented prior to unloading.

Premiums:

1. Showmanship (3-4 classes) pay back to top 3 in each class.
2. Classes (5-10 hd/class) pay back to top 5 in each class.
3. Grand Champion Steer and Heifer - \$300.
4. Reserve Champion Steer and Heifer - \$150.
5. All premiums will be paid in cash after the show.

General:

1. Shavings for bedding will be provided in barn.
2. The owner is responsible for the care and clean-up of his/her own animals.
3. Grooming chutes must be confined to the areas designated.
4. Number of entries may be limited pending number of entries.
5. All animals must be removed after show on June 12, 2011.
